

Dr. Suthiphand Chirathivat

Dr. Suthiphand is an Associate Professor of Economics and former Dean of the Faculty of Economics at Chulalongkorn University. He is also Chairman of the Ph.D. program in Economics, Chairman of Economics Research Center and Center for International Economics and editor of *Chulalongkorn Journal of Economics*. He has previously served as the Assistant to Dean of the Faculty of Economics and Business Administration at Kasetsart University as well as Director of the Center for International Economics and the Center for European Studies at Chulalongkorn University.

Concurrently, Dr. Suthiphand holds various professional positions including: Advisor to the Foreign Affairs Committee, the House of Legislative Assembly, Vice Chairman of Economics Discipline Committee, National Research Council, Honorary President of the Association of Former Students in France, member of the International Advisory Board, *ASEAN Economic Bulletin*, editorial member of *Asian Business and Management*, Executive Member of the Alliance Francaise of Bangkok.

Dr. Suthiphand previously held a position as Advisor to the Ministers of Foreign Affairs, Minister of Commerce, Minister of Agriculture, Minister of Finance, Deputy Minister of Transport and Communications and Economic Affairs Committee of the Thai Parliament. He was also Member of the APEC Panel of Independent Experts, Founding Member of the EU-LDC networks of the Netherlands Economic Institute, Member of the Triple-T Task Forces of the Pacific Economic Cooperation Council (PECC). He also served as President of the Association of Former Students in France, Thailand and Executive Member of the Economic Society of Thailand.

Dr. Suthiphand holds License es Sciences Economiques and Maitrise es Sciences Economiques, from the Universite d' Aix-Marseille in France. Later on, Dr. Suthiphand received D.E.A. es Sciences Economiques from Universite de Paris I-Pantheon-Sorbonne. Finally, he holds Doctorat de 3 cycle es Sciences Economiques from the Universite de Paris I-Pantheon-Sorbonne.
