2. Qualifications of Applicants

- Applicants must possess at least a bachelor's degree or its equivalent from an accredited university in any field of study. For candidates holding international degrees, the degree must be listed in the Office of the Civil Service Commission's approved list of recognized qualifications.
- 2. All applicants must meet the minimum English language proficiency requirements by submitting test scores from one of the following exams:
 - CU-TEP: Minimum score of 67
 - TOEFL: Minimum score of 71 on the iBT, 197 on the CBT, or 525 on the ITP/PPB
 - IELTS: Minimum score of 5.5

The English proficiency test must have been taken within two years prior to the announcement of eligible applicants.

Note: Applicants who have graduated from an English-medium program at a university recognized by the Office of the Civil Service Commission may be exempt from the English proficiency exam requirement.

- 3. Applicants are required to submit two letters of recommendation. These letters must come from professors and/or employers who are capable of evaluating the applicant's academic achievements and/or professional performance.
- 4. For applicants wishing to pursue Plan B (Individual Study in Economics or Applied Economics), a minimum of one year of work experience is required. Alternatively, applicants may submit a request for permission to apply for Plan B from the Admission Selection Committee, which will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
- 5. Applicants are encouraged to review further qualifications that may be announced on the official website of the program: https://www.econ.chula.ac.th.
- 6. All applicants must receive approval from the Admission Selection Committee to be considered for admission.
